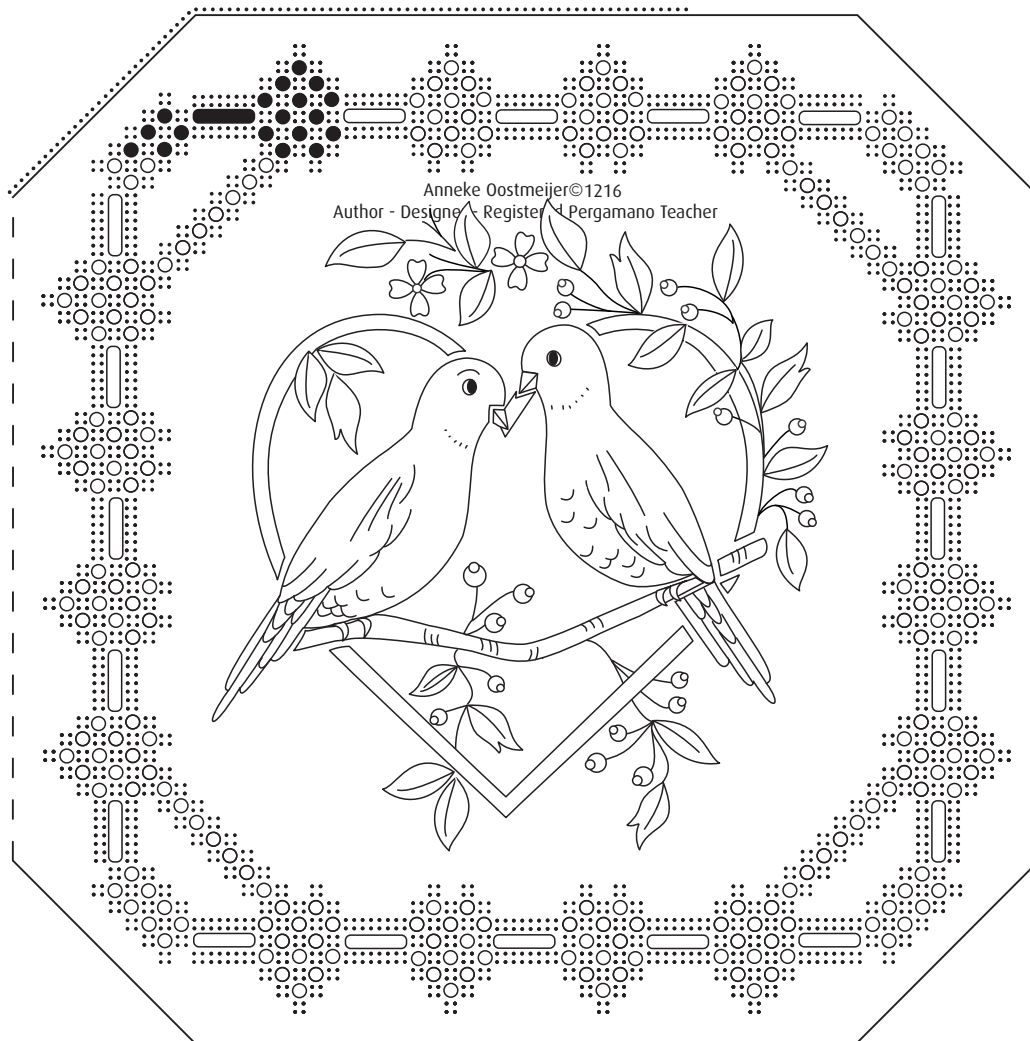


## Free Pattern



### **Two pigeons:**

The card is made of ordinary parchment paper, vellum paper insert is black No. 62536.

### **Tracing:**

The smallest ball embossing tool the veins leaves, berries ends, the white lines, etc. in the eyes pigeons, tree bough. Tinta black or East Indian black ink, the entire illustration.

### **Painting:**

With Tinta black or East Indian black: pigeons, stems, twigs, leaves, little flowers, tree, berries. Pintura white: veins in the leaves, berries end, twigs, eyes, wings etc. in the pigeon. The centre of the flowerhearts.

### **Perforation shallow**

With the 4-needle perforating tool according to the pattern.

### **Embossing:**

berries end, dots in the perforation pattern.

### **Perforating deep:**

Again with the 4-needle perforating tool according to pattern.

### **Cutting:**

Cut the sections A, along the outer perforations and cut the 4-needle perforations into crosses. See color image.

### **Finish**

Fold the card. Attach vellum parchment paper black in the card with spray glue. Perforate with the 4-needle perforating tool the outline of the card (by 3 layers). Cut the outlines along the outer perforations.
