



BIRD:

Technique: Perga Liners Dry with B pencils and paint with A pencils.

General:

Start everything very light in color, to put more and repeat.

Trunk: B1, B2, B3, B12, A17. **Twigs:** B3, A17. **Flowers:** B1, trace the flower petals. Little leaves: B6, A2. Flower Heart: B6, B8.

Bird:

B2: the darker regions in the wings, beak, head, eye, feet, everything very light. B1: bird head, wings. B16, B4, A4, A2: again wings. B8: back, head and belly area. B: belly (very little), feet. B16, B4, A4: bird head. (See color example).

Perforating shallow:

According to the perforation pattern with needles: Half Circle, 4-needle and Flower.

Embossing: flowers, petals, twigs, bird and motifs in the perforation pattern.

Perforating deeply:

Again according to the perforation pattern with the needles: Half Circle, 4-needle and Flower.

Cutting:

Cut 4-needle perforations into crosses.

Finishing:

Fold the card in half. Attach with spray glue a sheet of Rainbow parchment paper No. 1486 insert the card. Perforating the outline of the card (three layers) with 2-needle perforating tool and cut it along the perforations outline of the card.
